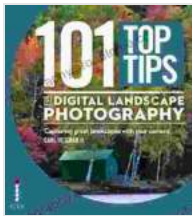

Chapter 1: Camera Settings

1. Use a tripod to keep your camera steady.
2. Set your camera to aperture priority mode (Av).
3. Use a small aperture (f/16 or smaller) to get a deep depth of field.
4. Use a low ISO setting (100 or 200) to minimize noise.

5. Use noise reduction to minimize noise.

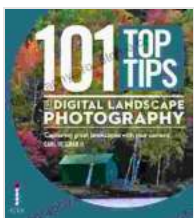
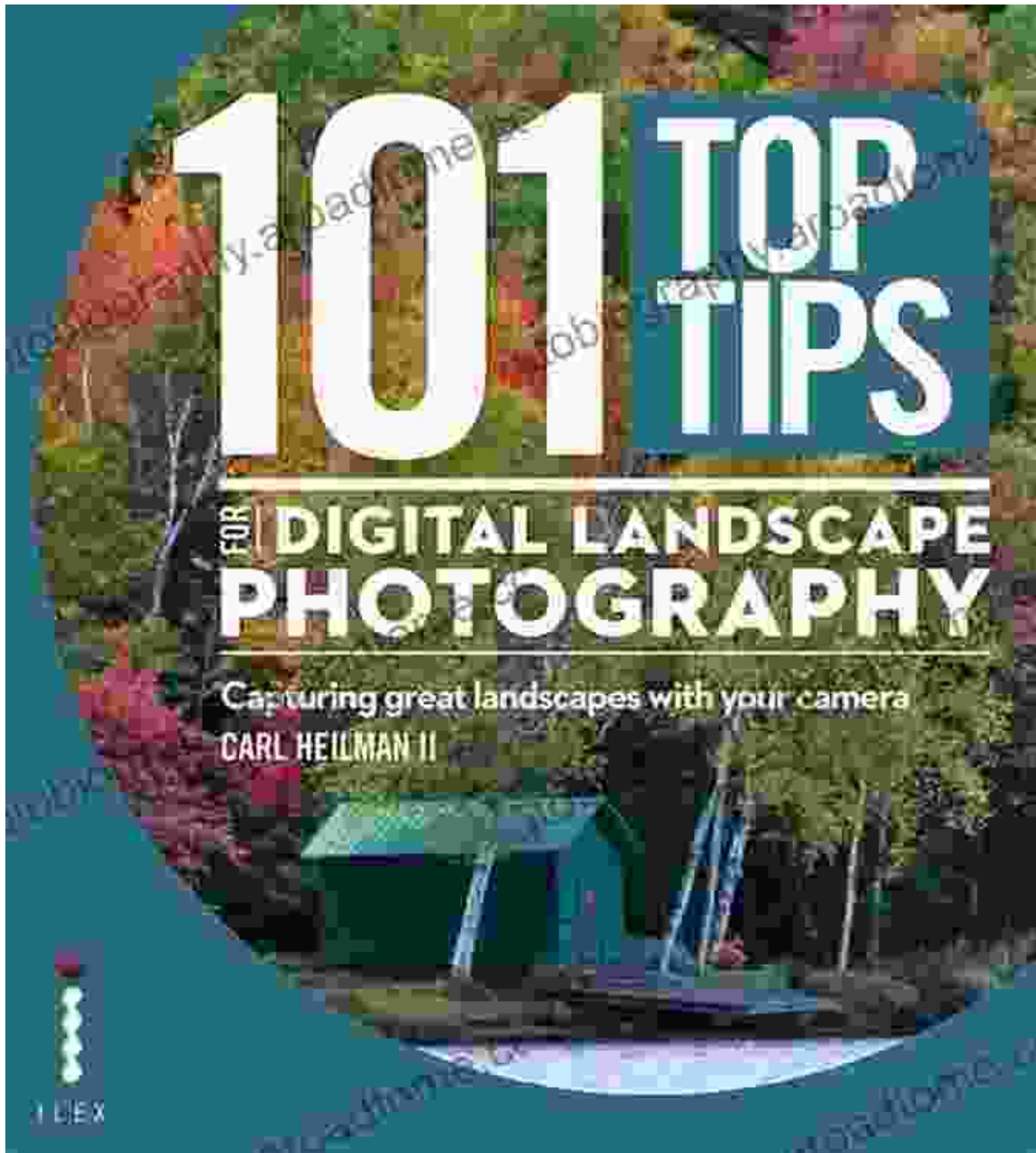
Chapter 5: Advanced Techniques

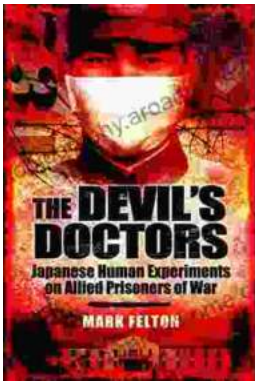

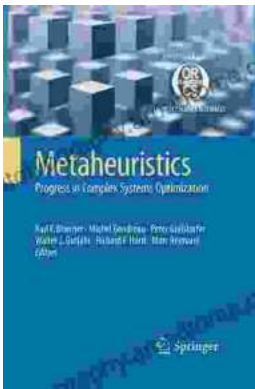
