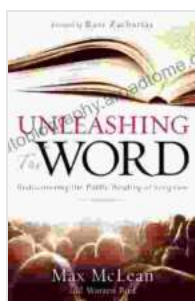

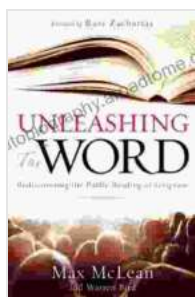
About the Author

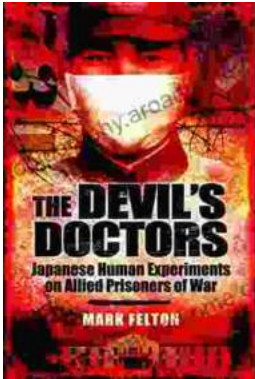

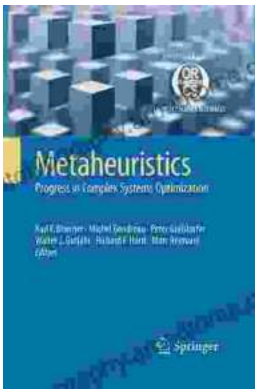
